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# Junior Programme Overview

**Our Junior Programme is an action-packed learning adventure for young learners, which gives them the best chance to learn and have fun during their time in London.**

Our courses are the perfect combination of communicative English lessons with fun activities and cultural excursions to create an exciting and unforgettable summer, experiencing London life.



## Ealing: the best area to study and explore.

Ealing is the perfect place for international students. It is multicultural, easy to get around, with lots to see and do. For instance, we have a large shopping centre and a huge park just behind our school! It's also a very family-oriented part of London, with 14 primary and secondary schools within Ealing.

WLES is only 30 minutes from Central London. It is rich in history, culture, sport, music and has an exciting international atmosphere.

We partner with Ealing Green College to run our Summer Junior Programme.

From 3rd July to 1st September, the programme will take place at Ealing Green College, which is next to Walpole Park, a short walk from our main campus in Ealing Broadway.

# English Class (mornings)



The course is especially tailored to suit the needs and interests of teenagers with a focus on creativity, fun and collaboration. Whether they are interested in science, technology, business, sports, music or art, our students can enjoy a topic-based syllabus through engaging in project-based activities that emphasise communication and core skills (Speaking, Writing, Reading and Listening) while expanding their vocabulary and grammar knowledge.

The programme has been developed to allow students to use their English language skills, imagination and creativity in project work, class discussions and fun activities.

Students will learn and practise English in a dynamic way through music, video, visuals and technology. Our Junior Programme is a great opportunity to make new friends with peers from around the world. Individuals, as well as groups, are welcome.

## Explore London

Join our Junior Social Programme to experience London by visiting traditional sights as well as hidden gems off the beaten track. Discover all the cool things to do in the capital with our fun, unique, insta-worthy excursions. Our learners' language development extends from the classroom to these diverse outings, as students are always accompanied by our teachers, who will make sure that the learning continues outside the classroom.

## Key facts about the programme:

- **Age:** 12-17 years old
- **Start date:** 5th June to 1st September

- **Programme timetable:** Monday to Friday. The group leaves the school at 13:30, and is dropped off back at the school at 18:00.

- \* *Programmed activities can be changed by the group leader. Other programmes may include cinema, bowling, cricket, mini golf, karaoke, darts, other famous museums, sights and parks.*
- \* *There will be one adult accompanying the group for every 10 students.*
- \* *Students are responsible for their own travel expenses and should have their oyster cards/travel cards ready before each trip.*
- \* *Students will be given some time to have their lunch between the end of their lesson (12:20) and the start of the Explore London activity (13:30).*
- \* *Students are responsible for their own food and drinks on trips. We advise all students to always carry a light snack and bottle of water, especially in hot weather conditions.*

# Afternoon Workshops

This year, we have 5 different workshops to choose from. Students can join any workshop, as long as they have booked their place by the previous Friday. We have a varied selection of exciting workshop options available:

## Football English

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<b>Available:</b>	Every Tuesday, from 13th June to 29th August
<b>Time:</b>	Classroom-based lesson from 13:00 to 14:00 Activity from 14:00 to 18:00
<b>Price:</b>	£35 per week (free if joining the week-long Explore London programme)
<b>Maximum class number: 15</b>	

Football English is designed for students who love football and would like to learn more about the game in an English-speaking environment. In the workshop, they will learn about:

- Position
- Formations
- Different styles of play
- Team talks
- Punditry
- Commentary
- Interviews with players and coaches
- Nutrition

After a one-hour lesson, students will take part in a football-related activity, which may be playing a supervised football match, or attending a stadium tour of a London-based professional football club.

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## Drama workshop

Drama is particularly valuable for presentation skills and expression in English and encourages teamwork and cooperation. Our drama workshops are led by an experienced theatre director. At the end of each week, there will be a performance, giving a chance for students to show what they have learnt to their peers. In the workshop, they will also:

- Practise pronunciation
- Improve self-confidence as well as communication and presentation skills
- Prepare to deliver a performance at the end of the week

Our STEM courses give your children the opportunity to learn crucial STEM knowledge and develop the skills needed in secondary education, all while having fun in an inclusive and interactive classroom environment. Students will:

- Speak about and share ideas on Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM)
- Practise mathematical skills and logic reasoning
- Enquire scientifically, developing their skills in questioning and critical thinking
- Experiment safely to prove or disprove their hypotheses
- Put their knowledge and skills to the test by creating and building within the context of what they've learnt
